BACKGROUND

Blackfordby College of Agriculture was founded in 1974 (then as the Tobacco Training Institute) by members of the Zimbabwe Tobacco Association. One day seminars for farmers were introduced in 1976, followed by the inauguration of a tobacco diploma course in 1977. Following diversification out of tobacco by most commercial farmers, the Diploma in General Agriculture programme was introduced in 2000, which is currently the main course offered by Blackfordby. The college is situated on Klein Kopjes Farm in Concession, Mazowe District, Zimbabwe.

The full-time diploma programme consists of four compulsory disciplines namely Animal Production, Crop Production, Farm Mechanisation and Farm & Agribusiness Management. The course is done in three taught trimesters, followed by a one year farm or agro-industrial attachment.
